MAHESH GROVER, J.

The instant petition is directed against the award of the Labour Court whereby reinstatement with complete back wages was awarded in favour of the workman. No stay was granted while admitting the writ petition. It would evidently mean that the award stands satisfied.

There is no representation on behalf of the workman-respondent no.1 .

If that be so then, the instant writ petition is disposed of as having rendered infructuous considering the fact that with no restraint order of execution of the award and with the efflux of time the respondent no.1 – workman in all probability would have retired from service. In case, respondent no.1 – workman has any subsisting grievance, he would be at liberty to approach this Court to seek revival of the instant petition.
