This petition is directed against the order dated 12.1.2015, dismissing the application filed by the petitioner under Order 32 Rule 15 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 [for short 'the Act'] for appointing him as guardian ad-litem of Raghbir Singh on the ground that he has been suffering from Schizophrenia.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has vehemently argued that the Court below has committed an error in dismissing the application without holding an inquiry and has relied upon a decision of this Court in the case of **"Dilbagh Singh Vs. Sawinder Kaur"** 2011(2) PLR 324.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and after examining the record, am of the considered opinion that there is no merit in his submission in view of the fact that the petitioner, when filed the petition and the subsequent facts tendered in his evidence, did not allege that he is suffering from Schizophrenia.

In view thereof, I do not find any merit in the present revision petition and the same is hereby dismissed.
