Challenge in the present petition is to the order dated 7.2.2015, passed by the learned court below, whereby the application filed by the petitioner for re-calling respondent No. 1-plaintiff for further cross-examination to confront him with original compromise dated 10.1.2008, was dismissed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the original compromise was already produced by the petitioner in his evidence, however, later on respondent No. 1-plaintiff produced a photo copy thereof and sought to prove the same by summoning the record from the court. The photo copy produced by him was tendered. As it was done after the plaintiff had already been examined, he is required to be summoned for further cross-examination.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, I do not find any reason to interfere with the impugned order. Once the original of the document is already on record, in my opinion, there is no need to summon respondent No. 1-plaintiff for further cross-examination to put him the photo copy of the document produced on record.

The petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
