The Lok Adalat through its award in FAO No.299 of 2013, has provided for additional amount of Rs.3 lacs over and above the amount awarded by the MACT to be paid within a period of two months. There is a reference to the amount as required to be paid in cash which cannot be corrected, if there is a direction for deposit within the period of two months. If the amount is deposited, the petitioner may move the MACT for issue of cheque for the same and if such an application is made, the Court shall issue the cheque of whole of the amount to the claimants.

The revision petition itself is incompetent but I still proceed to pass an order for the direction to be given which is simple in nature.

With these observations, the revision petition is disposed of.
