The petitioner has come up in civil revision against the order dated 25.11.2014 whereby in a petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, interim maintenance has been granted to the petitioner and her minor daughter @ Rs.18,000/- per month from the date of application.

A petition under Section 13 of the HMA for dissolution of the marriage was filed on 26.03.2014, which was performed on 27.07.2003. As per order dated 25.11.2014, the applicant-wife is a physically handicapped lady and cannot travel alone and require company of others. Her minor daughter Anakdeep Kaur is studying in Punjab Public School, Nabha. As per salary slip of the husband Kulwant Singh, his salary for the month of June 2014 was Rs.36,876/-. In a proceeding under Section 125 Cr.P.C. petitioner was granted Rs.5,000/- per month as maintenance. The respondent is an IAS

Officer and does not dispute the take home salary of Rs.36,876/-. Keeping in view the take home salary of the respondent, grant of Rs.18,000/- per month does not require any interference as the maintenance has to be granted to enable mother and the child to live in somewhat the same degree of comfort as in the matrimonial home.

Dismissed.
