Respondent is present in person.

She states through her counsel that she will not press her claim for maintenance if she is permitted to collect the rent from various portions of house in House No. 510, Sector-16, Panchkula. Recording the statement, I would clear that there is no further direction necessary and the petition for interim maintenance is treated as unnecessary. I make it clear however that petitioner husband will not prevent the respondent from collecting rent and if at any stage, obstruction is caused, the respondent-wife shall be at liberty to inform the trial Court and secure appropriate directions in that regard.

The civil revision petition is disposed of.
