In terms of order dated 05.11.2014, an affidavit of Dr. Avtar Singh, Principal Secretary to Government of Haryana, Transport Department, has been filed in Court today, by the learned State counsel in both the cases, which is taken on record.

As per the said affidavit, the claim of the petitioners in both the petitions for family pension, was considered in the light of various judgments of this Court, as also the Supreme Court, and they have been sanctioned family pension vide order dated 09.01.2015, a copy of which has

been annexed with the affidavit, as Annexure R-1.

A very fair stand has been taken by the State.

These petitions, are therefore, disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

The benefits, including arrears, as would be calculated in terms of the order dated 09.01.2015, be released to the petitioners, along with interest @ 6% per annum, from the date that family pension first accrued to them, till the actual date of payment thereof, which shall be within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
