SABINA, J

Petitioners have filed this petition challenging the order dated 23.01.2015 whereby application moved by the petitioners for summoning the register of Sakni, was dismissed.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and have gone through the record available on the file carefully.

Respondents No.1 and 2 had filed suit against the petitioners and others for permanent injunction. The suit filed by the plaintiffs was decreed by the trial Court. During the pendency of the appeal, petitioners moved an application that register Sakni which was produced in original when the statement of PW10-Jagdish Chander, Patwari was recorded, be summoned. The Appellate Court rightly dismissed the application as there was no order passed by the trial Court that the said register was to be retained on the Court file.

However, certified copy of the register of ownership Sakni No.0/496 village Kalanaur was duly exhibited as Exhibit PW 11/B and its Hindi translation was exhibited as Exhibit DA.

In these circumstances, there was no necessity to summon the register in question.

Dismissed.
