The plaintiff-Kuldeep Singh has filed the present revision aggrieved by the order dated 05.02.2013 (**P-2**), passed by the learned Additional District Judge, Moga, whereby his temporary injunction application under Order 39 Rules 1 and 2 CPC has been dismissed while setting aside the order dated 08.08.2012 (**P-1**), passed by the learned Additional Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Nihal Singh Wala directing the maintenance of the status quo regarding possession of the suit property between the parties.

None has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the respondent/defendant states that as per his information, the present revision petition has become infructuous since the learned trial Court has finally decided the suit for permanent injunction.

In view of the statement made by learned Counsel of the respondent/defendant at the Bar, the present petition stands dismissed as infructuous.

However, learned Counsel for the petitioner shall be at liberty to seek the revival of the same within four weeks from today in case the factual position is otherwise.
