Learned counsel for the State submitted that on verification of record, it was found that there are 310 landowners, who had to be paid the compensation. Out of them, 103 claimants have been paid the compensation. In the balance 207 cases, either the bank account particulars have not been furnished or the original landowners have expired and the legal heirs have not been able to furnish satisfactory proof. The moment requisite information is furnished, the amount shall be disbursed to them also. More than rupees two crores are lying with State Bank of India for disbursement as compensation to the landowners. He further submitted that the petitioner has been paid the amount of compensation due to him.

The fact regarding disbursement of compensation to the petitioner has not been disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Considering the aforesaid factual matrix, the present petition is disposed of as infructuous.
