Challenge in the present revision petition is to the order dated 12.02.2014 (Annexure P5), passed by the Civil Judge (Jr.Divn.) Ludhiana, vide which, the application, filed under Order 6 Rule 17 CPC for amendment of the written statement, filed by defendant No.2, the present petitioner, was dismissed.

Counsel for the plaintiff-respondent No.1 submits that the suit is of the year 1997 and has been pending for long and he would have no objection if the application is allowed and accordingly, does not oppose the present revision petition.

Accordingly, keeping in view the consent given by counsel for the plaintiff-respondent No.1, the impugned order dated 12.02.2014 (Annexure P5) is set aside. Resultantly, the amendment which is sought by the petitioner-defendant No.2, is allowed. The Trial Court shall allow the said defendant to file amended written statement. Keeping in view the fact that the suit was filed in the year 1997, the Trial Court shall ensure that the case is decided at the earliest.

With the abovesaid observations, the present revision petition stands allowed.
