SABINA, J.

Petitioner has challenged the order dated 27.08.2014 (Annexure P-12), whereby application moved by the petitioner for consolidating the suits filed by them against the contesting respondent, was dismissed.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record, available on the file carefully.

Petitioner had initially filed suit for declaration against the respondent and in the alternative had claimed decree for possession. Thereafter, petitioner filed another suit against the respondent seeking decree for permanent injunction restraining the defendant from interfering in his peaceful possession.

The learned trial Court rightly held that since the subject matter of both the suit was different, there was no occasion to

consolidate the suits.

No ground for interference is made out.

Dismissed.
