This petition is against the order dated 08.10.2012 by which evidence of the petitioner has been ordered to be closed.

Learned counsel for the respondent has submitted that the petitioner was declared a proclaimed offender in a case registered vide FIR No. 100 dated 29.9.2010, under Sections 420, 406,465,.467,468 & 471 of IPC at Police Station Khuian Sarwar, Tehsil Abohar, District Ferozepur. He has submitted that since the petitioner was declared a proclaimed offender, therefore, he should not be granted any opportunity to lead evidence.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that a false case has been foisted upon him by none else than the respondent in which the co-accused has already been acquitted.
