1. The petitioner says that there is a very strong dispute with reference to interest. There is a delay of 213 days in preferring the appeal. The application for condonation of delay was declined.

2. Delay will be condoned subject to the condition that the petitioner deposits the entire principal amount claimed by the petitioner to the credit of the appellate court and on such deposit, the respondent-plaintiff shall be permitted to withdraw the same. The deposit shall be made within a period of 4 weeks and if the amount is not deposited, the order passed already shall stand confirmed. The impugned order is set aside and the revision petition is allowed. The direction for deposit need not be treated as admission of any liability

on the part of the defendant-petitioner that the amount is payable.

The petitioner will be entitled to canvass for all the contentions already taken in defence before the trial court.

3. Revision petition is allowed, subject to the above condition.
