The challenge in the present petition is to the order dated 15.9.2007 whereby claim petition filed by the petitioner under Section 166 and 140 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 for grant of compensation of ₹7 lacs has been partly allowed and compensation of ₹3,000/- only has been awarded.

The present revision petition is for enhancement of the same. As per the latest judgments rendered by Hon'ble the Supreme Court, revision petition is not maintainable. The petitioner is at liberty to file an appeal against the said award for enhancement of the amount and seek condonation of delay owing to the pendency of the revision petition in this court as per provisions of Section 14 of the Limitation Act, 1963.

The civil revision stands disposed of.
