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K. KANNAN J. (ORAL)

1. There is no justification for approaching this Court against the order of closing the cross-examination of witnesses DW1 and DW4 recording the opportunity as nil. The power exists with the trial Judge himself to reopen the case and allow for witnesses to be cross-examined. The procedure has been set down by this Court in **Santosh Kumar Berry Vs. Nirmala Devi and others 2013(1) PLR 404.** The petitioners will approach the trial Court for appropriate orders for following the procedure laid down by this Court.

2. The revision petition is disposed of with the above observations.
