1. The impugned order is modified to the extent that the revision petitioners will be permitted to withdraw 8/9th share of the amount in deposit giving due credit to the amount which is already drawn and 1/9th of the amount under the award that is claimed by the respondent shall be retained and at the option of the parties to be

invested in any bank deposit yielding interest till the final decision before the Executing Court.

2. The revision petition is disposed of with the above modification.
