SABINA, J.

Vide this order, above mentioned two petitions would be
disposed of as the petitioners have challenged the order dated

24.2.2014 passed by the Executing Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that as per the order dated 26.10.1984, Dhanvir Singh had 1/10 share in the 2 *bighas* 19 *biswas*. The Executing Court had erred in directing the Local Commissioner to submit report qua the entire land measuring 11 *bighas* 5 *biswas*.

As requested by the learned counsel for the parties, the Executing Court is directed to pass a fresh order, in accordance with law.

Accordingly, impugned order dated 24.2.2014 is set aside and the Executing Court is directed to pass a fresh order, in accordance with law.

Both the petitions stand disposed of accordingly.
