Counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of this petition with liberty to take all the pleas, as have been raised in this petition, before the court concerned, at an appropriate stage but urges that since it is a suit for partition, time limit should be fixed so that further proliferation of litigation is avoided. It is also claimed that anything stated in the impugned order may not stand in the way of adjudication of substantive rights of the petitioner-defendant.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty. It is made clear that any observations made in the impugned orders would not stand in the way of the petitioner at the time of adjudication of substantive rights of the parties to the suit before the lower court. However, the time already fixed by the Appellate Court in the impugned order would be adhered to by the lower court while deciding the application under Order XXXIX Rules 1 and 2 CPC.
