Challenge in the present petition is to the order dated 27.2.2015, passed by the court below, regarding interim custody of the kids.

Learned counsel for the parties are agreed that the present petition may be disposed of with a direction to the court below for expeditious disposal of the main petition.

Learned counsel for the respondent submitted that the respondent will conclude her evidence before the court below upto 30.9.2015. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner will conclude his evidence by the end of December, 2015. The matter will thereafter be decided by the court below by the end of February, 2016.

It has further been agreed that during the intervening period, the respondent-wife will have visitation rights to meet the children on 1st

and 3rd Saturday of every month. The petitioner will leave the children in Mediation & Conciliation Centre in District Courts, Chandigarh at 10.00 AM on every 1st and 3rd Saturday and pick up back at 4.00 PM. The mother will have custody of the children during the intervening period. The petitioner will take back the custody of the children at 4.00 PM from Mediation and Conciliation Centre.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that as the children will be busy in examinations upto 24th/25th August, 2015, the schedule of meeting be fixed thereafter.

Let the arrangement for meeting start from 29th August, 2015, 19th September, 3rd October and onwards.

The Member Secretary, District Legal Services Authority, U.T., Chandigarh-cum- Incharge of Mediation & Conciliation Centre in District Courts, Chandigarh shall appoint a Mediator for supervising the handing over custody of children during the aforesaid period to either of the parents and ensure that no untoward incident happens.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
