Petitioner has filed this petition challenging the orders dated 04.12.2014 and 06.02.2015.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that respondents No.1 and 2 had filed suit for recovery. The same was decreed in *ex parte*. Petitioner has filed objections and has prayed that the house in question be released from attachment. The said objections had not been decided so far, whereas the sale/auction proceedings are still continuing. Learned counsel has submitted that the sale/auction proceedings be ordered to be not concluded till the decision of the objections filed by the petitioner.

In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the executing Court to decide the objections filed by the petitioner before confirming the sale.

Petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
