Petitioner has filed this petition challenging the order dated 27.02.2015, whereby application moved by the petitioner for summoning the record from the office of Block Development Officer, was dismissed.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record available on the file carefully.

Plaintiff has filed suit for declaration that he was owner of the suit property to the extent of 1/5th share. By summoning the witnesses in question, petitioner wants to prove two death certificates issued by the office of Block Development Officer qua deceased Agwanwati. However, the said deceased is not party to the suit nor has any concern with the suit in question. Therefore, the learned trial Court rightly held that the witness/record sought to be summoned

by the petitioner was not necessary for the just decision of the case.

No ground for interference by this Court, is made out.
