This application under Order 22 Rule 4, CPC, for impleading legal heirs of respondent No.4-Raj Kumar has been filed by the counsel for applicant/respondent.

It is mentioned in the application that respondent No.4-Raj Kumar has expired on 02.04.2015 leaving behind his legal heirs as mentioned in para No.3 of the application. It is also mentioned in the application that respondent No.4-Raj Kumar (deceased) had executed a Will

dated 19.03.2015 during his lifetime and as per this Will, the entire interest in the demised premises has come to his wife namely Smt. Madhu Aggarwal. The true photocopy of the Will is also annexed with the instant application as Annexure A-2. The true photocopy of death certificate of respondent No.4-Raj Kumar (since deceased) is also placed on file as Annexure A-1.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, it stands allowed and Smt. Madhu Aggarwal is impleaded as party in this case being legal heir of respondent No.4-Raj Kumar for the purpose of pursuing this case only subject to all just exceptions.

Amended memo of parties is already on file, same is taken on record.

This application under Section 151 CPC praying for withdrawal of the revision petition in terms of compromise dated 20.04.2015 (Annexure A-1) has been filed by the applicant/petitioner.
