Present revision has been filed assailing the order dated 14.5.2008 (P-2) passed by the District Development and Panchayat Officer-cum-Collector, Jalandhar in a petition under Section 7 of the Punjab Village Common Land Act, filed by the Gram Panchayat of village Jagraon for ejectment of the petitioner herein from the land measuring 65 Kanals.

Having heard learned Counsel for the parties, it is apparent that in the pending ejectment proceedings the petitioner(respondent therein) was proceeding to produce witnesses pertaining to the ownership of the property in dispute, which was rejected by the Authority for the reason that the said witnesses related to the ownership of the suit property, which in any case had been decided in the proceedings under Section 11 of the Punjab Village Common Land Act. No doubt the said issue regarding the title is pending

adjudication before this Court, however, for the said reason, the impugned order cannot be faulted with, accordingly this Court finds no fault with the approach of the learned Collector, whereby parties were ordered to complete their arguments. Whatever is the impact of the proceedings pending before them shall be considered at the relevant stage as and when reached.

In view of the above, this revision petition is dismissed with direction to the parties to appear before the Collector concerned on 03.03.2015 for completion of the pending proceedings.
