Challenge in the present petition is to the order dated 14.1.2014 passed by the learned Court below whereby the application filed by the petitioner under Order VI Rule 17 CPC for amendment of the plaint was dismissed.

When the case was taken up for hearing, considering the facts mentioned in the impugned order, learned counsel for the petitioner was asked to apprise the court about the status of the case before the Court below. However, she could not reply to the query made by the Court. The Registry was asked to get the status of the case.

As per the information received, the suit itself has already been dismissed by the learned Court below on 19.1.2015.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that as the suit itself has been decided, the present petition may be dismissed as infructuous.
