MAHESH GROVER, J.

The counsel who had filed the instant petition has since expired notice of the writ petition was issued to the petitioner for 7.10.2015 but he could not be served. Again the notice was issued to him for 28.10.2015. In another petition bearing CWP no. 2407 of 1995 filed by same counsel noticing the similar facts this Court has dismissed the writ petition with the liberty to revive the same, if any cause survives.

In the considered view of this Court since the petition remained pending for inordinately long time, there being no attempt made by the petitioner to either revive the earlier writ petition no. 2407 of 1995 and further noticing the fact that the present petition is only against adverse remarks in ACR with no consequential relief, I am of the considered view that the writ petition needs to be dismissed for want of prosecution with a liberty to the petitioner to revive the same in case any cause still survives. Ordered accordingly.
