1. There is no justification for arriving before this court for a witness of the plaintiff who has given his evidence in chief and he is reported to have run away from court. The court appears to have closed the plaintiff's side. The appropriate procedure will be to apply for reopening the case before the trial Court and seek for summoning the witness for continuance of examination. If he will not turn up on summons, the petitioner has adequate provisions of law for seeking for the arrest for being brought before the court.

2. The civil revision is disposed of with liberty aforesaid.
