Petitioners have filed this petition challenging the order dated 29.01.2015.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners would be rendered homeless as they are residing in the house in question for last 40 years.

Respondent No.1 had filed suit for possession of the land in question by way of demolition of construction raised by defendants. Suit filed by respondent No.1 was decreed by the trial Court vide judgment/decreed dated 10.01.2006. The appeal filed by the petitioners against the said judgment and decree was dismissed by the First Appellate Court vide judgment/decreed dated 04.12.2007. Thereafter, the decree holder initiated execution proceedings. Petitioners filed their objections before the Executing Court. Learned Executing Court rightly dismissed the objections filed by the petitioners as the Executing Court was

bound to execute the decree.

Hence, no grounds for interference by this Court is made out.
