Third party objections filed by the petitioner before the Executing Court in a decree for specific performance by sale passed in favour of Pishora Singh in suit titled “Pishora Singh Vs. Sohan Singh” have been dismissed. The petitioner claims that he is son of Gurdial Singh who had exchanged his land with Jagjit Singh and Hira Singh who were purchasers of the land in dispute from Mohinder Singh. It is claimed that said Mohinder Singh had purchased this land from judgment debtor on 28.09.2001. Against the order of dismissal of the objections of third party, he would be entitled to file an appeal before the District Judge, as per the observations of Apex Court in **Brahmdeo Choudhary Vs. Rishikesh Prasad Jaiswal and another, AIR 1997, S.C. 856** and full Bench judgment in **Gurram Seetharam Reddy Vs. Gunti Yashoda and another, AIR 2005 Andhra Pradesh 95.**

Dismissed as not maintainable with liberty to the petitioner to file appeal.
