Impugned in the present revision petition is the order dated 27.02.2013 passed by learned Addl. Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Mukerian, vide which the Court refused to appoint the guardian of defendant No.1 Sain Dass on the ground that he is mentally infirm. This court vide order dated 10.12.2013 directed the Head of the Department of Psychiatry, P.G.I., Chandigarh, for constituting a Board of Doctors for examination of said Sain Dass and submit its report.

The report has been received, wherein the Medical Board has opined that Shri Sain Dass can protect his own interest to contest a civil litigation in a court.

It being so, there is no illegality or infirmity in the impugned order.

Accordingly, the present revision petition stands dismissed.
