1. *Whether Reporters of Local Newspapers may be allowed to see the judgment?*

In the present revision the impugned order dated 16.02.2015 passed by learned Civil Judge(Junior Division), Panchkula. The operative part of the order is as under:-

“After perusing judicial file, this court scare-up that earlier also the applicant was permitted to compare the thumb impressions of Sh. Budh Ram endorsed on Vakalatnama and other documents with disputed thumb impressions. But as per applicant, thumb impressions present on the Vakalatnama and the written statement

are not clear enough. Although, regarding this, applicant neither submitted report of expert to the effect that above referred thumb impressions are not clear enough nor any other demonstration made from the side of applicant to this effect. Be that as it may, application in hand is hereby dismissed being general and vague in nature. Now the case is adjourned to 18.02.2015 for plaintiff evidence”.

It appears that the report of expert was not produced before the lower Court to the effect that the thumb impression on the power of attorney and the written statement are not clear enough. The said report has been annexed with the present revision.

In view of the matter the impugned order is set aside. The petitioner is directed to produce the said report before the lower Court so that lower Court can appreciate the same and pass appropriate order. After the said report is placed on the file of the lower Court, the lower Court will pass the order afresh on the present application.

Disposed of.
