Challenge in the present petition is to the orders passed by the courts below, whereby the application filed by the petitioner under Order 39 Rules 1 and 2 read with Section 151 CPC seeking interim injunction, was dismissed.

The prayer made by the petitioner was that the respondents-defendants be restrained from raising any construction on the suit land, as the same was a plot and the property was still joint. However, both the courts below did not find any merit in the contentions raised as in the revenue record produced by the respondents-defendants, the area was recorded as *gair mumkin makaan*. Once as per the revenue record, the construction was already existing on the spot, no illegality has been committed by the courts below in declining interim injunction to the petitioner restraining the respondents from raising any construction on the site in dispute.

Dismissed.
