The petitioners, who were the plaintiffs do not claim possession but merely wanted a declaratory relief that the sale deeds executed by certain persons on behalf of the society are not valid and binding on the plaintiff or the society. The plaintiffs are not parties to the transaction but want only a relief of declaration that the person who executed the sale deeds had not the competency to do so. Their entitlement to value the mere suit for declaration did not require the documents to be set it aside and pay ad valorem court fee. The order passed by the court below is erroneous and it is set aside. The civil revision is allowed.
