For the sheer indiscretion in not fling the certified copies of revenue entries which were relevant for the case, the petitioner is bound to be answerable for the delay and the inconvenience caused for the free flow of trial. The order passed is set aside subject to the condition that the petitioner pays costs of ₹15,000/- to the respondents. Needless to state that after the document is received and the plaintiff gives evidence, the defendant shall have right of offering contra evidence to the plaintiff's evidence.

2. The impugned order is set aside and the revision petition is allowed. The trial court will ensure that the cost is paid before the petitioner tenders the document as evidence.
