Petitioner has filed this petition challenging the order dated 17.12.2014.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record available on the file carefully.

Petitioner has filed suit for possession and permanent injunction. Vide the impugned order, the case has been sent to the Court of Civil Judge (Senior Division) for disposal as per law in view of decision given by the Apex Court in ***Faseela M. versus Munnerul Islam Madrasa Committee and another***, wherein it was held as under:-

17. The matter before us is wholly and squarely covered by Ramesh Gobindram. The suit for eviction against the tenant relating to a waqf property is exclusive triable by the civil court as such suit is not covered by the disputes specified in Sections 6 and 7 of the Act."

Hence, no ground for interference by this Court, is made out.
