Petitioner-Judgment debtor has assailed the order dated 14.05.2011, rendered by Civil Judge (Senior Division), Narnaul, vide which the execution petition has been dismissed as withdrawn, being fully satisfied, as also the judgment dated 02.08.2014, vide which the appeal preferred against the said order was dismissed.

Concededly, Rent Controller, Narnaul ordered eviction of the petitioner on 27.04.2005. Appeal against the said order also met the same fate, as the same was dismissed on 30.08.2008. Revision petition preferred by the petitioner was dismissed by this Court on 04.10.2008. Being aggrieved against these orders, petitioner had preferred a Special Leave petition before the Hon'ble Supreme Court. Concededly, as submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the same was also

dismissed on 31.03.2009. Possession of the demised premises has already been obtained by the decree holder. Learned counsel for the petitioner fairly concedes that no proceedings as regards the matter in issue are pending before any court.

That being so, no interference is warranted in exercise of revisional jurisdiction under Article 227 of the Constitution of India. Petition being devoid of merit is, accordingly, dismissed in limine.
