The suit of the plaintiff for mandatory injunction to adjust sum of Rs.80,011/- in the account of plaintiff was decreed. The defendants-respondents filed appeal. The said appeal was also dismissed upholding the order passed in favour of the plaintiff-petitioner. The plaintiff also filed an appeal claiming interest on the amount of Rs.80,011/-, which has been ordered to be adjusted by passing a decree for mandatory injunction. The appeal filed by the petitioner has been dismissed being barred by time.

I have heard the counsel for the petitioner and I am of the opinion that the plaintiff had not been able to satisfy the appellate Court regarding the existence of sufficient reasons for condonation of delay of 1 year and 9 months that too for claiming interest in suit for mandatory injunction.

No ground is made out for interference.

The revision petition is dismissed.
