Defendant No. 79 will have a right of cross-examination of the plaintiff and the order passed already stands set aside on the condition that the plaintiff is paid a cost of Rs. 10,000/- as condition precedent to avail of such liberty on the day the case is posted. Defendant No. 79 shall not ask for any time and if such time is asked, the court is empowered to close the evidence as nil cross-examination and proceed with the trial.
2. The impugned order is set aside and the revision is allowed, subject to the above direction.
