SABINA, J.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition qua petitioners No. 2 and 3.

Ordered accordingly.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has further submitted that petitioner-Raj Kumar had filed claim petition under Section 166 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (for short 'the Act) along with his minor children, claiming compensation on account of death of his wife, namely Kavita in the motor vehicle accident.

The Tribunal while allowing the petition vide award dated 27.08.2013, had granted compensation to the tune of ₹3,04,624/- to the petitioner. Out of the said amount, 50% was ordered to be released to the petitioner-Raj Kumar whereas remaining 50% amount

was ordered to be deposited in fixed deposit receipt. Petitioner-Raj Kumar requires the said amount for construction of his house.

Accordingly, this petition is allowed. The Manager State Bank of India, Mini Secretariat, Jagadhri, is directed to release the amount invested in FDR, in the account No. 33836932064 dated 15.05.2014 to the petitioner-Raj Kumar forthwith.
