Prayer in the present petition filed under Articles 226 and

227 of the Constitution of India is for quashing the office order dated 15.12.2002 issued by respondent No.4 and for issuance of direction to the respondents to release pensionary benefits alongwith arrears with interest.

Learned counsel for the Corporation has handed over the communication from the office by the XEN, Operation Division, UHBVN, Naraingarh, whereby it is informed that UHBVN is counting the daily wages service towards pensionary benefits as per latest instructions of the Nigam and the case of the petitioner is under process with the Pension Section of the Corporation. All the pensionary benefits due to the deceased petitioner on account of counting of daily wages service towards pensionary benefits will be released after getting approval from the CAO/Pension UHBVN, Panchkula.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to complete the necessary exercise with regard to pensionary and all other retiral benefits, along with interest, if admissible, within 4 months from receipt of certified copy of this order.
