RAJ MOHAN SINGH, J (Oral)

On 20.08.2015, following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for respondent No.2 states that petitioner can approach the Bank on any working day from 10 A.M to 4 P.M. Necessary reconciliation on account can be made in his presence. In this case, notice of motion was issued on 23.08.2004 on the ground that application under Section 8 (A-1) of Haryana Agricultural Credit Operation & Miscellaneous Provisions (Banks) Act, 1973 was hopelessly time barred as the same was filed after more than 16 years of date when the amount became due for repayment. The interim order dated 23.08.2004 was made absolute on 29.08.2006, when it was demonstrated before the Court that petitioner undertook to deposit Rs.20,000 before 30.11.2006 and Rs.15,000/- by 30.04.2007 inclusive with simple interest at the rate of 12.5 % per annum on the principle loan.

Let petitioner appear in the Bank on 27.08.2015. Mr. K.K.Goel, Advocate undertakes to apprise the status of this case to Bank Manager who in turn shall undertake necessary reconciliation based on record.

Adjourned to 21.09.2015.”

In compliance to aforesaid order, petitioner has already appeared before the Bank Authorities and necessary conciliation based on record has been done. Petitioner is satisfied with the outcome of reconciliation and intends to withdraw this petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
