Learned counsel for the petitioner states that additional issues which were sought to be raised in accordance with pleadings were not framed by the Court below. Of the two issues which the counsel for the petitioner wants to be framed, I would think the issue relating to ownership raised against the landlord is irrelevant and I will deem necessary to consider one issue as relevant, namely, whether there exists the relationship of landlord and tenant between the petitioner and respondent qua the property in dispute. I dispense with notice to the respondent, modify the order already passed and direct the Rent Controller to frame the above said issue and dispose of the case in accordance with law.

The civil revision petition is disposed of.
