SABINA, J

Petitioner has filed this petition challenging the order dated 10.04.2015 (Annexure P-6), whereby application moved by the petitioner directing the plaintiff-respondent No.1 to give his specimen handwriting, was dismissed.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record available on the file carefully.

Plaintiff has filed suit for possession by way of specific performance of agreement to sell dated 27.12.2005. During the pendency of the suit, petitioner moved an application directing the plaintiff-respondent No.1 to give his specimen handwriting so that the receipts issued by the plaintiff-respondent No.1 could be got compared with his standard handwriting. The learned trial Court while dismissing the application has held that the receipts relied upon by the petitioner were neither signed by any person nor it had been mentioned as to whose accounts were settled by said receipts. Moreover, the receipts in question were never put to the plaintiff in his cross-examination. The reasons given by the trial Court while dismissing the application are sound reasons.

In these circumstances, no ground for interference by this Court, is made out.
