Vide order dated May 4, 2015, findings have already been given by this Court that no ground is made out to interfere in the order passed under Section 13-B of the East Punjab Urban Rent Restriction Act, 1949, for short 'the Act', on account of delay caused by the tenant – petitioner in filing an application under Order 18-A (4) of the Act.

No affidavit has been filed by the petitioner as such this petition is dismissed. However, in the interest of justice to enable the petitioner to vacate the premises, two months' time is granted from today. In case the

premises is not vacated, the landlord- respondent would be entitled to execute the ejectment order.
