1. The revision petition is against the order of the Rent Controller treating the cross-examination of two witnesses of the applicant to be treated as Nil. The revision petition itself is not competent and the petitioner will be at liberty to approach the very same court with the prayer to recall the witnesses for cross-examination in the light of the observations made by this court in **Santosh Kumar Berry Versus Nirmala Devi and others in Civil Revision No.5639 of 2012, decided on 25.09.2012.**

2. The revision petition is disposed of but the petitioner will be at liberty to approach the Rent Controller for appropriate consideration of his request and the Controller will pass suitable order in the light of the law laid down in the said judgment.
