SABINA, J

Petitioner has filed this petition challenging the orders dated 12.02.2015 and 25.03.2015.

During the course of arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner has restricted his prayer to the extent that the petitioner be granted one effective opportunity to lead her evidence at her own risk and responsibility. Learned counsel has submitted that despite due diligence, petitioner could not conclude her evidence as short adjournments had been granted by the trial Court.

Keeping in view the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, it would be just and expedient to grant one effective opportunity to the petitioner to enable her to conclude her evidence. Respondent has filed suit for possession against the petitioner. So far, petitioner has not examined any witness in support of her case. In case,

petitioner is granted one effective opportunity to enable her to lead her evidence, the *lis* between the parties will be disposed of on merits.

Accordingly, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to grant one effective opportunity to the petitioner to enable her to lead her evidence at her own risk and responsibility, subject to payment of ₹2,500/- as costs. Costs be deposited with the legal service authority. Thereafter, the trial Court shall proceed further with the case in accordance with law.
