On the previous date of hearing, it was stated that driver of vehicle had died. This court granted time for impleading his LR's. Counsel says that it has not been possible to produce original licence. There is also plea that revision is against the order dismissing the application for setting aside the ex parte award. The claimants, who secured award, have not secured any benefit so far. I do not think it appropriate to keep the proceedings for 11 years for any adjudication and more so when service on LR's of deceased could not be effectively taken. The revision is dismissed in default.
