Both the parties agree that if there should be an amendment to brought, the defendant will have to cross-examine the landlord who has come from France to give evidence, without asking for any time. The order already passed is set aside and the amendment is ordered to be incorporated in the statement. The defendant will carry out the cross-examination including the averments which are permitted to bring by means of an amendment. The trial Court shall not give any adjournment for cross-examination of the witness and close evidence if such a plea is made.

The order is set aside and the revision is allowed subject to the above observations.
