Revision is brought against an order declining permission to the defendant to plead by means of an amendment that the suit was bad for non-joinder of necessary parties. It is a suit for damages for malicious prosecution and defamation. The defendant wanted to contend that the SSP, who registered the complaint, must be impleaded. It is wholly unnecessary and I find no prejudice caused by declining to permit the amendment brought by the defendant. The order is maintained and the revision petition is dismissed.
