JASWANT SINGH, J.(ORAL)

Defendant no.11 is in revision aggrieved against the order dated 28.07.2008 (Annexure-G) whereby he was directed to be proceeded against ex-parte; further challenge is to the order dated 5.1.2012 passed by the learned Additional Civil Judge(Sr. Divn.), Kharar whereby on his application for setting aside the ex-parte order, defendant no.11 was permitted to join proceedings from the stage he has put in appearance rather than 28.07.2008.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the parties are agreed that the present revision has become infructuous since during the pendency of the revision the suit itself has been disposed of in the light of compromise arrived at between the contesting parties.

In view of the statement made by the learned Counsel for the parties at Bar, the present revision petition is disposed of as infructuous.
